The Earth in the Solar System (Geography)

Key points :

1. **Celestial bodies:** All the objects that we see in the sky such as the sun, the moon ,the starts are called celestial bodies.
2. **Stars :** The stars are celestial bodies and have their own heat and light. The sun is also a star.
3. **Planet :** There are celestial bodies that do not have their own heat and light. They reflect the light they get from stars. We live on the earth, a Planet .
4. **Satellite :** A satellite is a smaller celestial body and revolves around the Planets. Moon is the only satellite of the earth.
5. The earth is a unique planet where life is possible due to water and air.
6. **Solar System :** The sun, eight planets, satellites and some other celestial bodies known as asteroids and meteoroids form the solar system.
7. The Pole star indicates the direction to the North.
8. **Constellation :** A group of stars forming various shapes is called a constellation
9. **Galaxy;** A huge system of stars is called Galaxy.
10. **Universe:** Universe is a vast, infinite heavenly space which comprises all the heavenly (celestial)bodies . It includes stars, Planets, dust or gases and several galaxies of stars.
